Sequence of Basic Job Steps	Potential Accidents or Hazards	Recommended Safe Job Procedure
Job brief and JSA meeting	Confusion	Meeting should present all aspect of job so the entire crew has a clear and concise understanding
Use of body harness	Improper use and fit, injury	<p>Full body harness must be correctly worn whenever fall protection is required. The harness should fit snugly and comfortable.</p> <p>When harness is used for fall protection it must be fitted with a lanyard that incorporates a shock absorbing system.</p> <p>All harnesses must be used according to the manufactures recommendations.</p> <p>Have harness fit checked before use by another member.</p>
Fall protection equipment	Improper use resulting in injury	Hook up lanyard high whenever possible. Never attach to a hand rail or scaffolding.
Inspection	Damage of equipment Improper equipment	<p>Equipment must be inspected before and after every use for signs of wear and tear or damage.</p> <p>Modifications to any fall protection equipment other than those performed by the manufacture may result in failure and are strictly prohibited.</p>
Maintenance	Damage of equipment	<p>Safety equipment which is worn or damaged must be destroyed so it cannot be put back into use and then discarded.</p> <p>Order replacements</p>
Storage	Damage	Safety equipment must be stored properly to avoid damage
