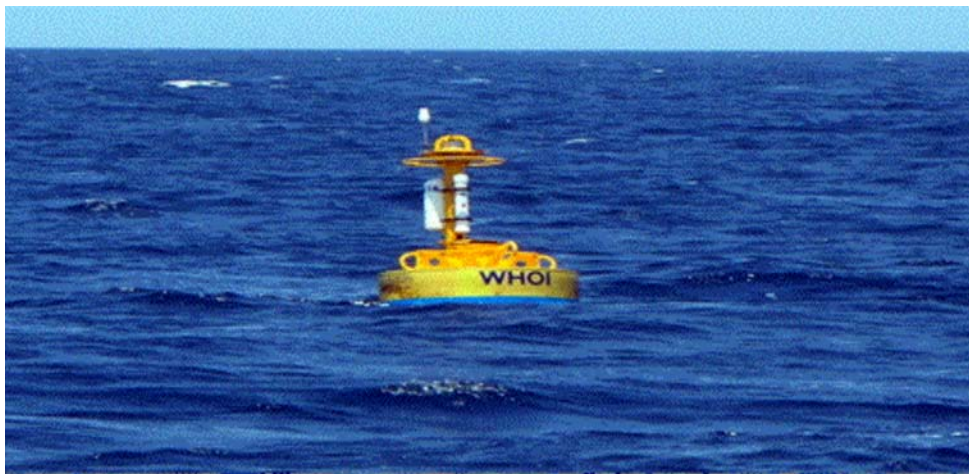

## DIVING SUPPORT SERVICES COMPLETED FOR WOODS HOLE OCEANOGRAPHIC INSTITUTION



PROFESSIONAL COMMERCIAL DIVING SERVICES WERE REQUESTED TO ATTEND THE WOODS HOLE OCEANOGRAPHIC RESEARCH VESSEL "SAVANNAH" OFFSHORE JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA. THE R/V SAVANNAH WAS ENGAGED IN RIGHT WHALE MONITORING OPERATIONS IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC. DIVING SERVICES WERE CONTRACTED TO ASSIST WITH ATLANTIC RIGHT WHALE SUBAQUEOUS MONITORING INSTRUMENTATION AND MOORINGS.



LOGAN DIVING & SALVAGE MOBILIZED MEN AND DIVING EQUIPMENT TO THE VESSEL IN THE ST. JOHNS RIVER AND SET UP A PORTABLE SURFACE SUPPLIED DIVING SYSTEM ON DECK ON THE TRIP OFF SHORE. DIVE PLAN DEVELOPMENT WAS COMPLETED WITH THE R/V SAVANNAH'S CAPTAIN AND CHIEF ENGINEER. JOB SAFETY ANALYSIS WAS COMPLETED FOR A WORKING DEPTH OF 80'- 90' FSW. DIVING AS DIRECTED, LOGAN DIVING & SALVAGE COMPLETED THE REQUIRED TASK SAFELY AND EFFICIENTLY. THE DIVE TEAM AND EQUIPMENT WAS RECOVERED AND RETURNED TO LDS'S WAREHOUSE AND FACILITY IN JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA.
