Equipment was assembled in Jacksonville, Florida using one of Logan's containerized deep sea diving spreads. The spread then mobilized to GITMO via the "Guantanamo Bay Express" barge towed by the TransAtlantic Lines tug "Spence".

Dive team mobilized aboard a Military Air Lift Command transport plane from Naval Air Station, Jacksonville (NAS Jax).



Dive team members surveyed existing conditions, provided underwater rigging and cutting as required and provided all underwater services thru to completion. All old substructure piling were located, cut, and extracted for replacement with new members.
