LDS ASSISTED WITH CASUALTY EMERGENCY RESPONSE, ASSESSMENT, FUEL RECOVERY, AND REFLOATING OF A SUNKEN TUG IN JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA

SALVAGE REPORT

LOGAN DIVING & SALVAGE WAS CONTRACTED TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY RESPONSE, SURFACE SUPPLIED DIVING SYSTEMS, MANAGEMENT, COMMERCIAL DIVERS, DIVE BOATS, AND ANCILLARY EQUIPMENT TO ASSIST WITH THE SALVAGE AND RECOVERY OF A SUNKEN TUG IN JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA.

INITIAL ASSESSMENT IN INVESTIGATION REVEALED OVER 20,000 OF FUEL ON BOARD IN 6 SEPARATE FUEL TANKS.

DIVE TEAMS SAFELY PENETRATED THE WRECK, PLUGGED ALL TANK VENTS, MAPPED OUT FUEL MANIFOLDS AND HOOKED UP HOSES FOR REMOVING THE FUEL. FUEL REMOVED WITH NO SPILLS OR DAMAGE TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

DIVE TEAMS THEN SET ABOUT RIGGING THE VESSEL FOR DEAD LIFT AND DEWATERING.

ONCE RIGGING WAS COMPLETE, A HEAVY LIFT CRANE BARGE WAS USED TO REFLOAT THE VESSEL BY LIFTING AND DEWATERING SIMULTANEOUSLY.

FUEL REMOVED, VESSEL SALVAGED AND REPAIRED.
