Pinch point occurs when a part of your body is caught between two objects	Not using handles to close draws Carrying heavy loads and setting down	Always use handles and door knobs to shut doors and draws as well as lockers.
Protect yourself from pinch points by identifying them in you work place.	Heavy and moving machinery presents far more serious pinch points risks.	Plan in advance how and were you are going to move the load and make sure the load is not to heavy for you Respect the danger zone and keep a healthy distance from heavy loads
	Machinery that is being repaired.	Lockout/Tagout is another important procedure used in protection from pinch points. Avoiding pinch point accidents involves safety sense whether its a simple painful pinch or a potential death trap
